### Today's Gospel Reflection

The God whom Jesus reveals is not a solitary being, but a relationship- a dynamic, circular movement of self giving and self-emptying love. The Father gives all to the Son; the Son, in turn, offers himself completely to the Father, even to the point of death. The Spirit is the love that flows between them, uniting Father and Son in perfect communion. Though we are created in the image and likeness of this God, our relationships often mirror only a dim reflection of the Trinitarian life, marked as they are by varying degrees of self-interest and self-seeking. In God, there is only pure, unreserved self-gift. We see this most clearly in the Father's sending of the Son into the world, and in the Son's willing self-surrender, so that we might receive the Spirit who makes us true children of God-participants in the divine communion of love.

*Lord Jesus, grant that our whole life may become a living praise to the glory of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. May every thought, word, and deed reflect the love and unity of the Triune God, in whose image we are made. Amen.*
