Today's Gospel Reflection

What is the netherworld whose gates will not prevail against the Church? The Greek word Hades is also translated as hell or death. But these are images signifying the realm that stands against God's Kingdom of love. On earth, this Kingdom is represented by the Church, the community of believers born out of the loving sacrifice of God's Son. As the Church lives up to its calling, it becomes a formidable force of love that the gates of the netherworld cannot resist. Attempts to destroy the Church through persecution paradoxically renewed her and deepened her love commitment. The Church celebrates today the feast of her pillar-apostles Peter and Paul, who followed their Lord on the path of loving sacrifice. The Church, bathed in the blood of its martyrs, indeed stands on the rock-foundation of love, and the gates of the netherworld cannot remain shut against the power of love. For love conquers all.

*Lord Jesus, thank you for calling us to be part of your holy people, for whom you
and your martyrs lovingly offered your lives. Amen.*
