Today's Gospel Reflection

Both the treasure-finder and the pearl-seeker sell all they possess to gain what they have discovered. Likewise, to possess the Kingdom, one must be willing to relinquish everything else, for the Kingdom tolerates no rivals. Only when a person is ready to be emptied for the sake of this supreme good can there be room for the Kingdom to take root. And when the Kingdom enters, it fills one's life completely. The phrase "Kingdom of heaven" refers to God's sovereign rule- his loving and redemptive rule supremacy in the world and within each person's life. To let God reign is to yield in complete obedience and surrender every aspect of life to him. Thus, to pray, "Thy Kingdom come," is to express a readiness to let God's will be done on earth- as fully and faithfully as it is in heaven.

Lord Jesus, help us to recognize the absolute value of the heavenly Kingdom, which eclipses and relativizes all other values. Amen
