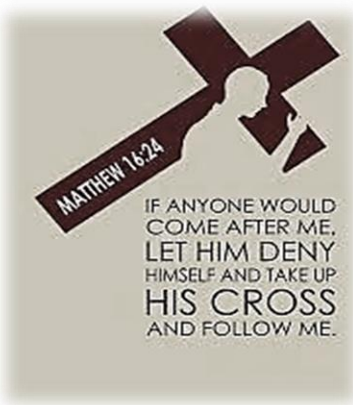

The theme for the 2026 Season of Creation is **"Living Water"** emphasising ecological restoration and spiritual renewal.

This year the season will be observed from **September 1st to October 4th** culminating on the feast of St Francis of Assisi.

The theme **"Living Water"** draws from the biblical vision **Ezekiel 47:9-12** where water flows from God's sanctuary, gradually deepening to restore barren lands, revive waters and sustain flourishing ecosystems.

This imagery symbolises both spiritual renewal and ecological responsibility, calling participants to immerse themselves in the waters of creation and actively safeguard the environment.

The symbol for 2026 represents the connection between faith practices and environmental stewardship, encouraging communities to reflect on their role in protecting fresh water resources, biodiversity and ecological health.
