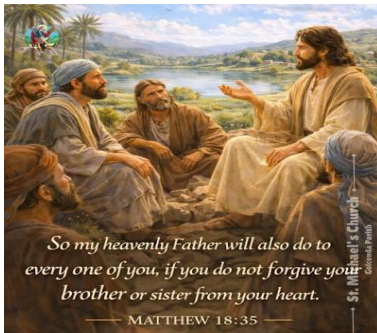

IMMERSION IN LIVING WATER
Ezekiel 47:9, 12

Long before we measure rainfall, monitor droughts or debate water policies, we encounter water as something deeply personal. The gentle rhythm of waves on the shore, rain tapping against a window, a mountain stream winding through a forest, children laughing as they splash through a river. Water has always spoken. The question is whether we have learnt how to listen. It begins with contemplation, before we can respond to creation's cry we first need to hear creation's song.

Imagine stepping outside early in the morning, you leave behind your phone, your to-do list and the constant noise that fills everyday life. You walk toward a river, a lake, the sea or perhaps only a small fountain in a nearby park. You stop; you breathe.

Slowly a new rhythm begins to emerge. The sound of flowing water, birds calling in the distance, leaves moving gently in the wind. For a few moments, nothing demands your attention except the gift of simply being present and something remarkable happens. Immersion in creation becomes your prayer.
