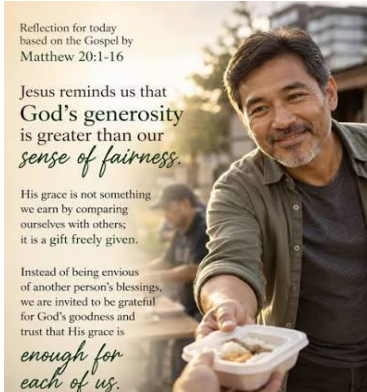

IMMERSION IN LIVING WATER
Ezekiel 47:9, 12

Come to the Water

This year's theme "Living Water" is more than an image. It is God's invitation. Throughout scripture, water is where life begins, where healing takes place, where God's people are renewed and where Christ meets those who are searching.

In the vision of the prophet Ezekiel, a small stream flows from God's temple. At first, it seems insignificant, yet with every step it grows deeper until it becomes a river that restores everything it touches. Today the temple is also the community of believers gathered in Christ (1 Cor 3:16; Eph 2:19-20). When we come together in Him rivers of living water flow from us too for the healing of creation.

"Where the river flows, every living creature will live" (Ezekiel 47:9)

Perhaps this is how ecological conversion begins – not with extraordinary actions, but with a heart willing to step in to God's river.
